Celebrating Achievement at Burrough Green

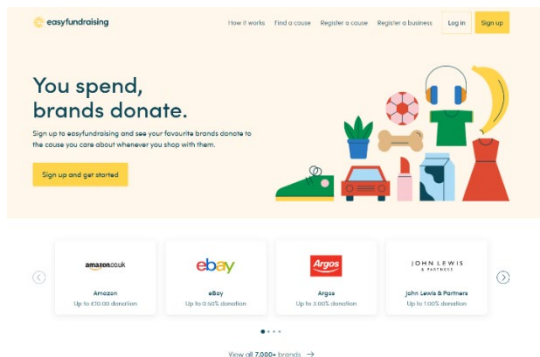
Every Friday, in our assembly, we recognise and celebrate children who have shown evidence of our school value Aspiration, Resilience and Kindness.

Teresa Class	James – Charlie – Omar

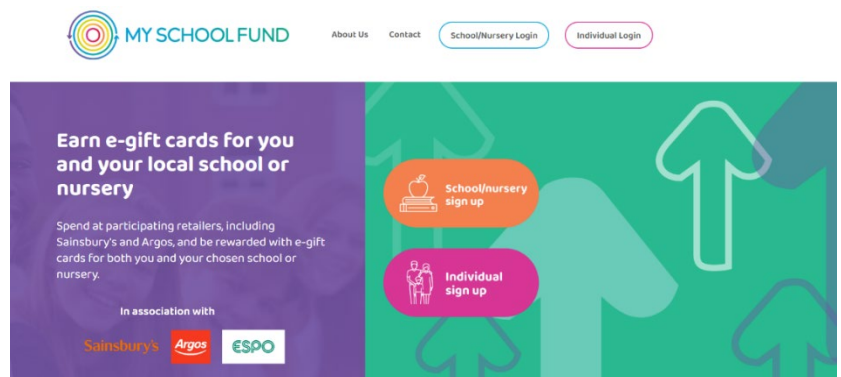


Don't forget to use the "Easy Fundraising" and "My School Fund" when you are doing your shopping!
