Dear Sir/Madam,

Cambridgeshire County Council is proposing to make alterations to Burrough Green Primary Academy. The proposals relate to establishing an Enhanced Resource Base provision at the school, enabling them to provide vital SEND spaces supporting learners with an EHCP and Autism primary need.

The proposals form part of the county-wide SEND strategy to develop capacity for specialist places in mainstream and special schools. A graduated approach to provision, underpinned by the SEND focus on “Inclusion for all”, meaning that additional places for SEND will be required in mainstream schools, in resourced provisions or units attached to schools, as well as in special schools.

To make changes to a school, the local authority must carry out a consultation with the school’s governing body, parents of children on roll at the school as well as other wider stakeholders.


The consultation starts 19/01/26 and will run for a period of 4 weeks until 13/02/26. Full details of the proposal and how you can make comments can be found on the Cambridgeshire County Council website. Search for ‘School changes and consultations’.

A consultation event will take place at Burrough Green Primary Academy on **05/02/26 9:00-10:30am** where you can find out more. A further event will take place online **via Teams on 05/02/26 6:00-7:30pm** and representatives from the school and the County Council will be in attendance at both events to answer questions.
