



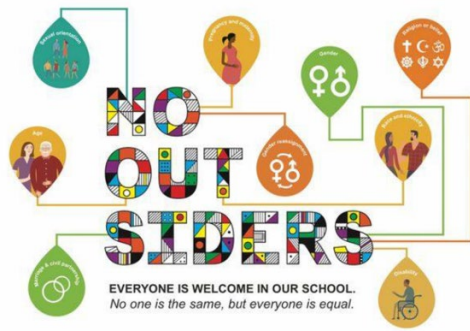
Dear Parents and Carers

### **NO OUTSIDERS: We Belong Here**



On **Tuesday 3rd December**, we will holding a parent's morning for our new PSHE scheme – NO OUTSIDERS: We Belong Here.

I will tell you all about the scheme, why it exists and why we are using it as well as sampling some of the texts that the scheme uses. As part of the morning, I will be reading one of the picture books and looking through a lesson plan so you fully understand what we are trying to achieve here at Burrough Green.

I am exceptionally excited about this curriculum development. It will enable us to further embed diversity and inclusivity across our curriculum and community. Schools strive to promote inclusivity and diversity, but it is a difficult task – most efforts seem to be a 'bolt on' and there is no or little legacy left behind. This scheme – implemented the 'Burrough Green Way' - will buck this trend and help to ensure the thread of diversity and inclusivity runs through our school and community.

The session will take around 30-40 minutes and I anticipate starting at 9am. Some Teresa parents have already had the opportunity to see a NO OUTSIDERS lesson (after the class assembly) and the feedback was very positive.

**All children at Burrough Green will be using the scheme** so please come along and find out about it. See you all in the school hall on the 3rd December at 9am!
