Science

Seasonal Changes

- Observe changes across the four seasons
- Describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies



Animals including humans

- Identify and name animals that eat meat only, plants only and those that eat both



Vocabulary: seasons, summer, change, flowers, blooming, observe, northern hemisphere, carnivore, predator, prey, meat eater, herbivore, plants, omnivore, meat, plants, humans

PHSE – Changing me – My body



- Name parts of the body
- Tell you some of the things I can do and foods I can eat to be healthy
- Know that we all grow from babies to adults
- Express how I feel about moving to Year 2
- Talk about my worries and my good feelings
- Share my memories of being in year 1

Phonics



- Explain what has been read and explain meaning of unfamiliar vocab
- Make inferences on what is being said / done
- Answer a range of Q in simple, written form
- Read words with alternative spellings
- Recap tricky words
- Read phase 5 set 5 speedily

Vocabulary: Phoneme, grapheme, suffix, GPC, digraph, trigraph, schwa, inference, vocabulary

Computing - Programming B

- Create and debug and predict simple algorithms using scratch



Vocabulary: Scratch Jr, Bee-Bot, command, sprite, compare, programming, debug, algorithms

PE – Athletics

- To move at different speeds over different distances
- Run using opposite leg to arm
- Taking bigger strides when running faster
- Use a slower pace for longer distances
- Develop balance
- Jump and land with soft knees and on the balls of feet
- Develop changing direction quickly
- To explore hopping, jumping and leaping for distance



- Develop throwing for distance and accuracy
- Vocabulary:** Balance, bend, control, direction, further, hop, jog, hump, leap, overarm, quickly

Mathematics

- Explore time – sequencing events, days of the week, months, hour and half past
- Place value to 100
- 2D and 3D shape
- Consolidation



Vocabulary: half past, hour, minute hand, clock, before, after, o'clock, half past, morning, afternoon, evening, earlier, later, clock, face, hour, hand, o'clock, time, minutes, day, week, month, year, , first, next, then, after, before, last, order, sequence, more than, less than, greater, equal, 2d and 3D Shapes

Art - Mechanisms – Moving storybooks • Experiment with slides – 3D William Morris – Clay print tile

Vocabulary: mechanism, movement, design, experiment, texture, tile, clay, 3D, pattern, print



RE - Why do Jewish families say so many prayers and blessings?

- Talk about what happens on Shabbat
- Know why Jews build a Sukkah
- Identify when Jewish children pray and say blessings
- Identify how I can show someone I am thankful for what they do for me.

Geography -Our world

- Name and locate all 7 continents
- Name and locate all 5 oceans
- Recognise maps of the British Isles with its countries

Literacy

- Explain what has been read
- Use adjectives before nouns
- Use adjectives that describe size
- Join 2 predicates with coordinating conjunctions 'but and 'and'
- Use direct speech in a sentence
- Use the prefix un-



Vocabulary: speech, said, character, conversation, conjunction, and, but, join, sentence, adjective, size, big, small, tiny, huge, large, little, compare, Adjective, noun, prefix, un-, describe, setting, story, explain, retell, question, answer
