Hello again everyone.

Assessment Week

It's been assessment week this week and the children are performing so well. They really are making the most of their learning opportunities this year.

As the scores roll in (and many assessments are still to be completed), I can share the following as examples of the hard work that the children are doing and the learning that is taking place.

In Year 3 the average (yes average) reading score is 110.9 – this may mean very little to you, but when I say that 100 is the national average – it shows how well that cohort are doing. It also represents a rise of almost 10 points since the Easter data was collated! Massive thanks must go to Mrs Chubb and Miss Burton for their excellence – on behalf of the children, thank you both!

Data here is used to inform teaching and next week, staff will be analysing the data, highlighting strengths and weaknesses to pass to the next teacher – this will ensure we hit the ground running in September and give the children exactly what they need to progress.

Transition

All of Year 6 will back together again today. They have been at their various schools having their transition. 2 students attended Bottisham Village College on Monday and Tuesday and 11 more went to Linton Village College on Wednesday and Thursday.

The children I have seen are full of stories and new experiences, which is amazing to see.
